KHS&S ANNOUNCES ORGANIZATIONAL CHANGES TO INTERNATIONAL OPERATIONS

KHS&S International Realigned into Two Business Units to Increase Responsiveness to Expanding Geographic Base

(ANAHEIM, CALIFORNIA, U.S.A.) KHS&S, one of the largest design-assist building companies in the world, today announced changes to the structure of its international subsidiary, KHS&S International. The changes, designed to provide management greater autonomy and responsiveness to a growing number of geographic markets, create two distinct international operating units that will each focus on securing and completing large-scale interior/exterior construction projects in assigned geographic regions.

KHS&S International-Asia will have primary responsibility for Southeast Asia, including Hong Kong, People's Republic of China, Macau, Singapore, Malaysia, Philippines, Brunei and Indonesia. Headquarters for the Asian operation will be in Hong Kong.

KHS&S International-Middle East will have primary responsibility for the United Arab Emirates (UAE), India, Bangladesh, Vietnam and Bangkok. Headquarters for the Middle East operation will be in Bangkok.

"Since expanding internationally some 15 months ago, the number of geographic markets in which we are working or pursuing projects has increased substantially," says Philip Cherne, KHS&S chief operating officer (COO) responsible for global operations. "This structure allows us to continue operating under the KHS&S brand while providing faster decision-making and streamlined communication within smaller and defined geographic markets." Cherne added that this refined structure also lays the groundwork for adding additional units as opportunities in new regions increase.

Both entities will continue to maintain access to centralized corporate services including preconstruction, design, estimating, scheduling and global procurement.

To facilitate organizational changes, KHS&S also announced the following personnel assignments:

KHS&S International-Asia: Colin Cheong has been named principal / chief executive officer (CEO) for KHS&S-Asia. Cheong, formerly principal of KHS&S International, is responsible primarily for business development and will report directly to the KHS&S Corporate Board of Directors.

Tom Stapleton has been named KHS&S-Asia's chief operating officer and will be responsible for the business entity's overall operations.

T.S. Tan has been named KHS&S-Asia's director of field operations. Tan will be based in Hong Kong and Macau.

Donald Lau has been named operations manager for Singapore and Malaysia. Lau will be based in Malaysia.

KHS&S International-Middle East: In addition to his KHS&S-Asia responsibilities, Tom Stapleton has been named managing principal/CEO of KHS&S-Middle East where he will report directly to the KHS&S Corporate Board of Directors. In this capacity, Stapleton will be responsible primarily for all Middle East business activities.

Roel Kwaspen has been named KHS&S-Middle East general manager. Formerly KHS&S International general manager, Kwaspen will be responsible for all Middle East operations. Kwaspen will be based in Bangkok.

Barry Cummings remains director of operations for all Middle East operations and will be based in Bangkok.
